# AT THE HEART OF A PHOENICIAN CITY

Housed in the former offices of Postmaster General Barrochin, Grand Hôtel Beauvau is an iconic building in Marseille's Vieux Port. Inaugurated in 1816 along the famous Quai de la Fraternité, it is the city's first and foremost hotel. The imposing stone structure, dating back to 1781, boasts a heritage-listed seafront façade accentuated by tall windows and azure shutters.

We have added a contemporary touch to the carefully preserved authenticity of this elegant and timeless place, much beloved by prominent travelers of days gone by - Frédéric Chopin, George Sand, Alfred de Musset, Alphonse de Lamartine and Jean Cocteau – who have sojourned here. Beautifully patinated furnishings from the 19th century blend harmoniously with vibrantly colorful fabrics that evoke Provence. In the guest rooms, travelers luxuriate in chic comfort inspired by the theme of adventure.

Metro: lines 1 and 2 (station: Vieux Port). Bus: lines 83 and 61 (bus stop: Vieux Port). By car: take the "Centre Ville-Vieux-Port" exit from the A7, A50 and A55 highways.
